## Scholarship Overview



During his years at WAHS, Sam acquired a love of Social Studies, language (French & Latin), music (saxophone and clarinet) and travel (Camp Conrad Weiser Voyager Program). After graduating in 1987, Sam attended the University of Pennsylvania, receiving a BA with concentration in 20th century Europe- an History. He continued his musical interests, fostered throughout his years at Wyomissing, as a member of the Penn band. He went on to receive a masters degree at the University of Pittsburgh and added Russian to his already impressive list of accomplishments. In 1999 Sam achieved his ultimate career goal of becoming a member of the US Foreign Service and received a dream

assignment as the US mission to the European Union in Brussels as his first post. His promising career was cut short when, seven weeks later, he died of natural causes while in Berlin. This scholarship hon- ors Sam's memory as a gentle, compassionate person with a wonderful smile and sense of humor who loved and served his country and fellow man.
